## Keep it in sight!

You should stay below

# 400ft



You must keep your drone in sight at all times.

It's illegal to fly "first person view" (using goggles or solely by reference to a screen) on your own, there are special rules you need to follow

Don't fly a toy, be a



Modern drones weighing more than 500g are sophisticated and powerful pieces of technology. They can do cool things, and are great fun, but they aren't toys.

Start seeing yourself as a drone pilot in order to have fun and stay safe and legal.

## Do your checks!



Just like pilots of full-scale aircraft, do your pre-flight checks.

By taking responsibility and **flying legally & safely** you will help the public perception of drone flying.

## KEEP US ALL FLYING!



*It's your responsibility to keep out of the way!*

## Keep a lookout & listen... for other aircraft when you fly

## You're in control!



It's your responsibility to make sure you know the law regarding drones in the UK

## Don't fly near airports!



It's a criminal offence to endanger any other aircraft. Stay well away from airports and airfields.

## Keep your distance! | 150m



It's illegal to fly your camera drone over or within **150m** of a built-up area

**In addition to this rule:**

It's **illegal** to fly near or over large groups of people, and **illegal** to fly your camera drone within **50m** of any person, vehicle, building or structure not under your control.
